

Commodity Codes

ONLINE SEPTEMBER | NOVEMBER 2022

Incoterms 2020

ONLINE OCTOBER | DECEMBER 2022

Incoterms are a set of rules which define the responsibilities of sellers and buyers for the delivery of goods under sales contracts. Shippers worldwide use standard trade definitions (Incoterms) to spell out who is responsible for the shipping, insurance, and tariffs on an item.

With new administrative requirements for trade between Great Britain and Northern Ireland, it is important that businesses have a clear understanding of Incoterms and establish the correct term with their seller.





International Documentation and Customs Procedures

ONLINE NOVEMBER 2022

This course will consider the impact of the latest UK Customs Procedures which have evolved under the Union Customs Code (UCC) for both importers and exporters. 




